PhotoLine contains a special function, not very frequent among imiga processing software:
A generator for custom made **Calenders!**

Mainly if you are owner of a color printer or plotter, you will be amazed by this function.

Please select "File" - "New" - "Create Calender" from the main menu.

First you will have to select the type of calender you would like to generate with PhotoLine:

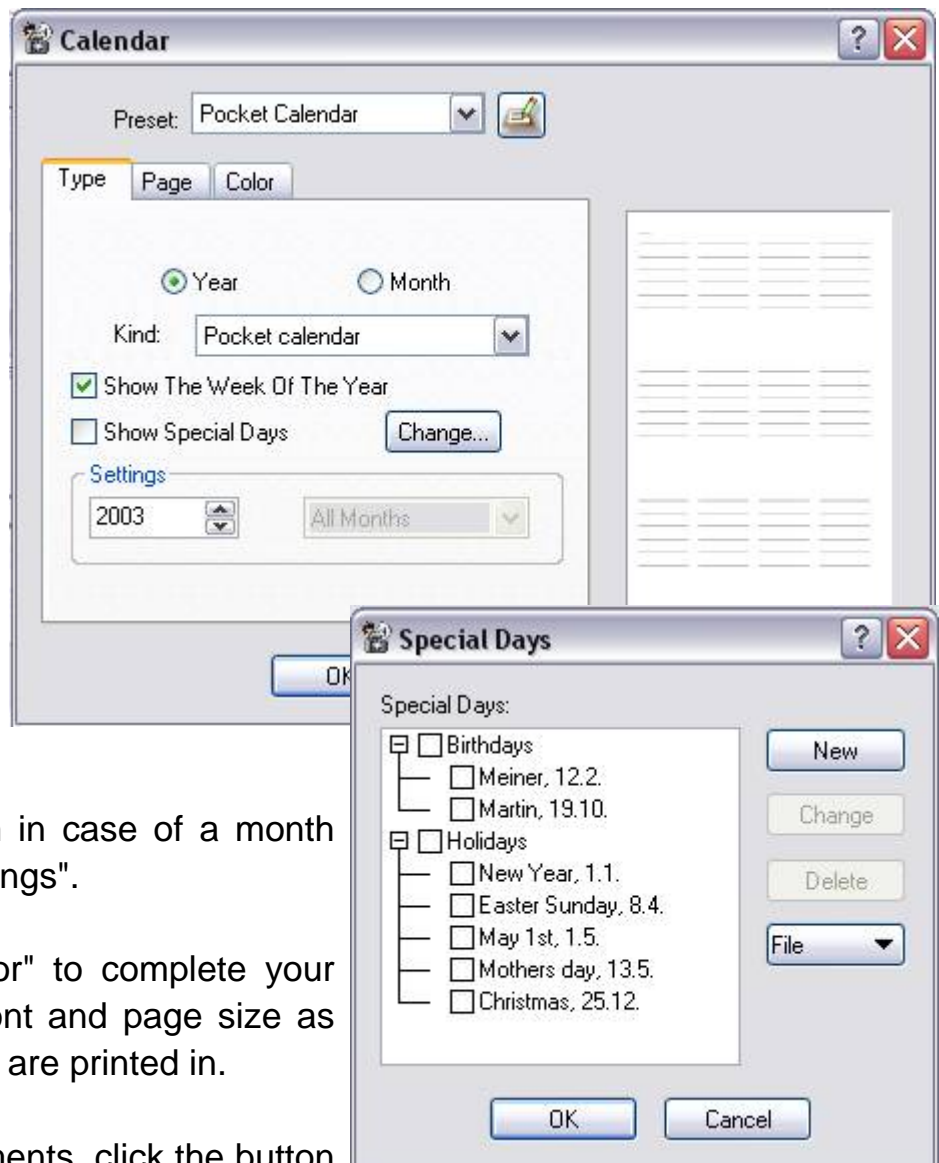
A **month calender** generates one sheet per month, while a **year calender** prints all months of a complete calender year on one sheet.

You may as well chose one of the Presets in the pull-down list.

Enter the desired year (and month in case of a month calender) for your calender in "Settings".

Select the items "Page" and "Color" to complete your calender design. You can define font and page size as well as the colors the different items are printed in.

If you are pleased with your adjustments, click the button right of the preset list, enter a new preset name and save the new adjustments.



The item "Type" shows two subitems:

"Show the week of the year" shows the calender week indicated on the calender, very useful for business calenders!

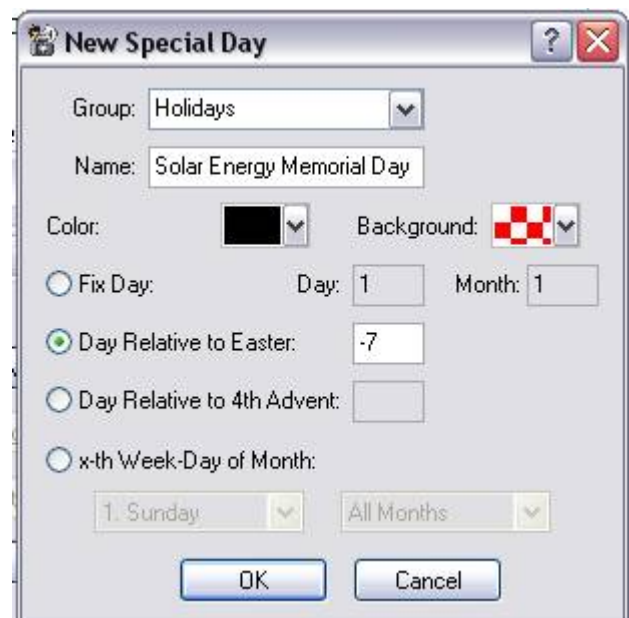
"Show special day" lets you print public or other holiday as well as your very individual special days like anniversaries and birthdays.

You can select either of groupes for printing and edit all special days: Press "Change" near the "Show Special Days" entry.

Then you can create new and edit or delete old special day entries.

You can even generate new groupes like "Concert dates", "Anniversaries" and so on. Each group, ä well each entry is selectable for printing or not on your calender.

Hint: Not all calender types have enough space for printing of the special days. If the calender design is too small, just the color indicates a special day.



You can define regular special days with fixed date, relative to easter, advent 4th (last sunday before Christmas) or as fixed week day of a month. In the example above we generated a special Solar Energy Memorial Day 7 days before easter!

For generating the calender, PhotoLine generates a document with a group of layers. This group contains one layer with the number of the year. Then, in case of a year calender, you will get an additional group for each month.

In every group one text layer contains the definition of the days and the other layers contain the calender design.

If the special days are enabled, each special day generates an own layer

So you can still edit the calender design after generating the calender with all editing commands of PhotoLine. This is mainly necessary if you generate small calenders: The text size for the special days might require to be decreased.

Hint: You cannot "undo" the generation of a calender. If something goes wrong, just delete and start over, PhotoLine remembered your last adjustments.
