

You already know PhotoLine as a top image processing software. You can use it for Desk-Top-Publishing as well. Web Design is one more application where PhotoLine is very helpful.

But **did you know PhotoLine contains a computer game?** And a SUDOKU solver?

CROSSFIRE

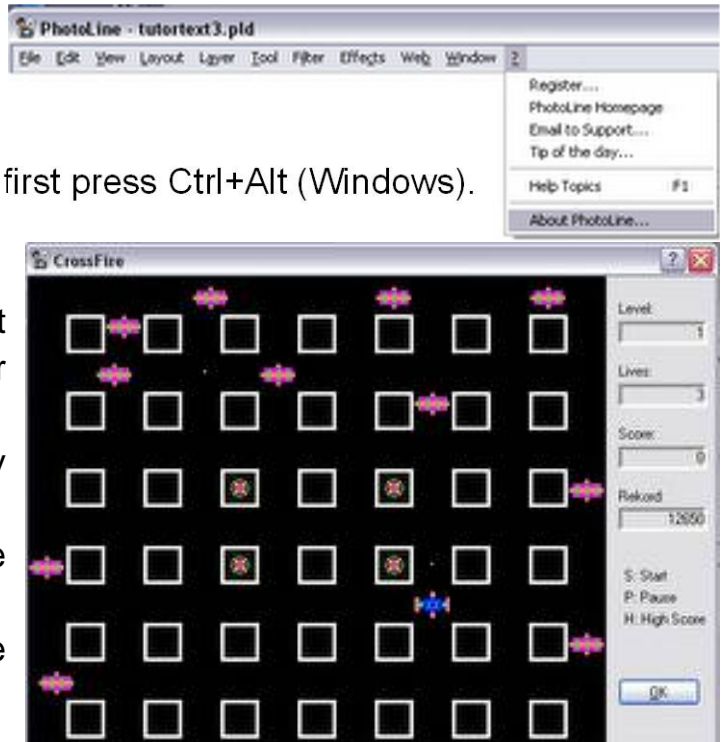
Try opening "?" - "About PhotoLine", but first press Ctrl+Alt (Windows).

This will open CrossFire, a simple but nice, almost self-explaining shooter program.

Start with "S". Move your spaceship by the cursor keys.

Press Shift + a cursor key to shoot in the desired direction.

Press "P" for pause and "H" to see the highscores.



If you like to design you own spaceship, you can open Photoline\ Default\ CrossFire\CrossFire.pld. There you can find 26 small 32x32px drawings for the "participants" of the game on a transparent background.

CrossFire.hsc contains the highscore data. You may change the sound files CrossFirexxx.wav as well while you keep the original filename.

SUDOKU

Open "?" - "About PhotoLine", but this time first press Ctrl+Shift (Windows). This opens a SUDOKU solver. Enter the known numbers and press "Berechnen". You will get the solution.

Press Shift + "Berechnen" and the fields are cleared.

"Schliessen" = Close
